




2013 Live Well, Age Well Summit Electronic Voting Polling Results*



A total of 109 participants responded to this question.


Question 2: Percentage of organizations that feel that they help in a specific region


Question 3: Percentage of organizations that feel that they help with that specific age group


Question 4: Attendance of Previous Community Vital Signs Meetings






Question 4: Attendance of Previous Community Vital Signs Meetings by Sector


Question 5: Percentage of organizations that feel that they could make an impact given the needs of the aging.



Question 6: Which option best describes how your organization is working together with stakeholders from other sectors to improve health outcomes? By Sector




Question 6: Total number of organizations that stated they were working together with stakeholders from other sectors through contractual/fiscal relationships to improve health outcomes, By Sector




Question 6: Total number of organizations that stated they were working together with stakeholders from other sectors through collaborative, coalitions or associations to improve health outcomes, By Sector




Question 6: Total number of organizations that stated they were working together with stakeholders from other sectors through the sharing of information to improve health outcomes, By Sector



Question 6: Total number of organizations that stated they were not currently working together with stakeholders from other sectors to improve health outcomes, By Sector




Question 7: Can your sector or group address the priority areas that were identified during this summit by the community?





Question 8: Which health components are critical in improving educational attainment?





Question 8: The Community Based / Non Profit Sector: Which health components affect educational attainment?





Question 8: Health / Human Services Sector Which health components affect educational attainment?





Question 8: The Government Sector: Which health components affect educational attainment?





Question 9: Do you think your organization could help address one of the critical health components in improving educational attainment?



Question 10: Percent of organizations that feel that a specific factor has the biggest impact on accessing health services for San Bernardino County residents?




Question 11: Percentage of how each organization feels they can help with the inability to physically access care for those 60 years and older





Question 12: Percentage of how each organization feels they can collaborate on dental care for the aging adult population.






Question 14: Percent of organizations that have specific programs or services that support a culture of living well and making healthy choices


Question 15: Percentage of respondents that feel that a specific health issue has greatly impacted their workforce
