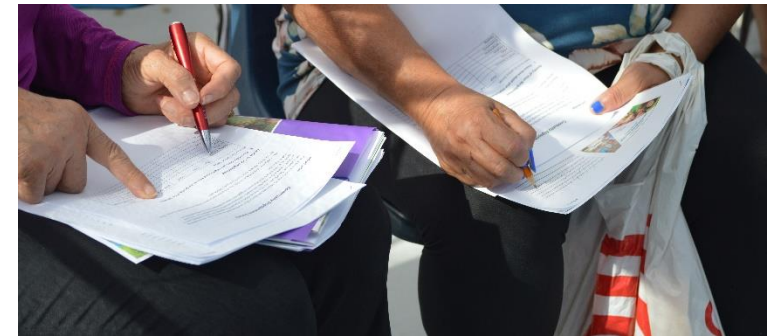
# Family Assistance Center (Fam Stop)
