



Education

Revisit Strategy #33 – Improve data sharing. Status: Keep and expand

Issues:

- Learning loss in education. Students not socially and emotionally engaged.
 Modality of learning has changed. Emotional interaction has taken a toll due to COVID.
- Need for resources for social emotional health needs and challenges.
- Concern for the students returning and integrating to a new grade level and/or school

Economy

Recommended: COVID-19-Specific, Commercial rental assistance to protect commercial property owners. Working with both state senators on this.

Issues:

- Quality attainable rental housing is disappearing workforce housing
- Lack of childcare especially hitting working women and primary caregivers in general
- Funding for Career and Technical Education (CTE) workforce needs to pivot as jobs will morph moving towards advanced technology, retrain people into new jobs. Work at the education level to increase access to the CTE programs that are vital there is currently not enough room in the programs to take students.
- **Internet access** needs to become a utility, and accessible to all. Provide to vulnerable populations at no cost. Have support from county schools.

Safety

Recommended: Adding equity as a GOAL/OBJECTIVE and we monitor progress towards legislation

- Equity needs to be more integrated into our plans for safety.
- Include the partnership with FBO and how cultural issues impact
 COVID and treatment.
- Address distrust of the medical professions as it relates to culture.
- Need to educate community on law enforcement's role.

Access to Health & Wellness

Issues:

- Residents navigating the health system to find services and information and use of technology.
- Health Literacy understanding the complexity of the COVID-19 virus and illness.
- Stress, anxiety and distrust, knowing how to cope and manage, mental stress.
- **Need to increase community health workers** and **trainings** and highlight need for increased cultural competence.
- Need CHW trainings to establish cultural competence.
