 - Requires parent/legal guardian to be present and sign consent for minor
 - County-run Sites, State Sites, Pharmacies.
- **Moderna and Johnson & Johnson authorization from FDA: 18+**
 - Hospitals, Physician Practices, Pharmacies

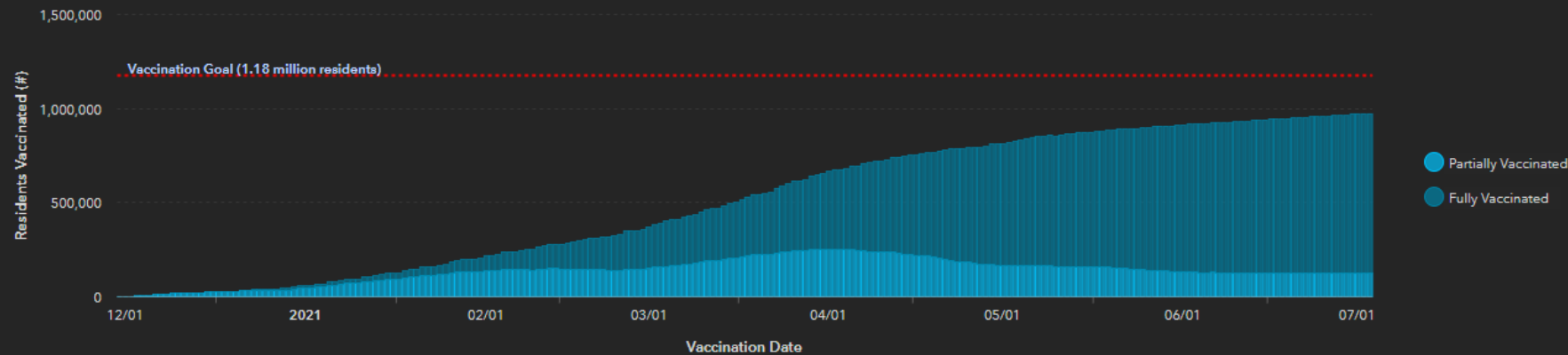

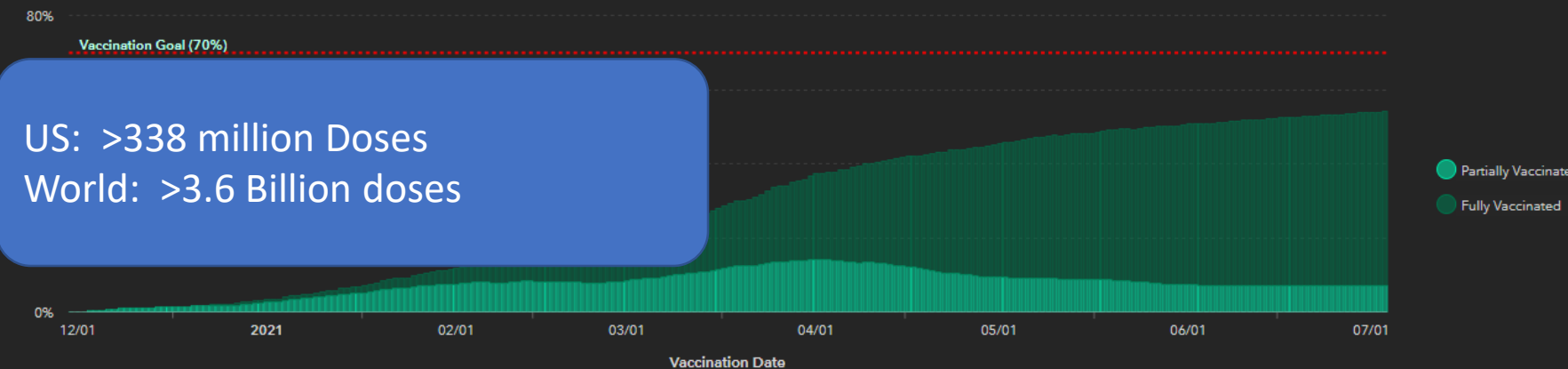
